Operation Christmas Child

At their meeting last Wednesday (10/14), the consistory voted to discontinue Church on the Hill's support and affiliation with Operation Christmas Child which is operated by Samaritan's Purse. Concerns were raised during the Worship Committee meeting last week about hurtful and demeaning comments made by the CEO and president of Samaritan's Purse, Franklin Graham, about the LGBTQ community and Muslims. These concerns were then referred to consistory. The consistory acknowledged all the good done for children around the world through Operation Christmas Child, but felt the comments made by the CEO were hateful and damaging to the Christian witness and to our ministry and community at Church on the Hill. The deacons will be exploring other possible partners in addition to considering pouring more of our energy and generosity into our White Christmas partners.

If you have questions about this decision, please reach out to a member of consistory. For those who took shoeboxes during worship on 10/11, you can still fill them and donate, but the church will not be collecting them. You will need to either mail them or identify a different drop-off location.
