Music Notes

This morning's anthems are from two different periods. Locus Iste by Anton Bruckner (1824-1896) was composed in 1869 while Philip W. J. Stopford's (1977-) The Spirit of the Lord is a very recent work. Locus Iste was written for the dedication of the votive chapel of the New Cathedral in Linz, Austria. Ever since it has been regularly used for the dedication or anniversary of sacred spaces. While no scriptural reference is given for the piece there is common agreement that the stories of Jacob's Ladder – "Surely the Lord is in this place..." – (Genesis 28:16) and the burning bush – "...for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground." – (Exodus 3:5) are the basis for the text. Listening to the quiet beauty of the piece it is easy to miss the power of the words: "This place was made by God"! As you listen we encourage you to look with awe at this Sanctuary and Chancel; for surely the Lord is in this place and it is holy ground.

The Spirit of the Lord is dedicated "For the Enthronement of the Archbishop of Philadelphia, Most Reverend Charles J. Chaput, O.F.M.Cap., September 8, 2011." (O.F.M.Cap stands for Order of Friars Minor Capuchin) The text is from

Isaiah 61; but more importantly, is part of the ministry of Jesus. In Luke 4:16-18 Jesus preaches in Nazareth and quotes Isaiah as follows (in part), "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because he has anointed me;..." After concluding the reading Jesus goes on to say in verse 21 "Today...in your hearing this text has come true." This scene is often regarded as the beginning of Jesus's ministry.
