The sanctuary and pews have been thoroughly cleaned in preparation for worship today. During the worship service, we ask that you continue to **wear your masks for the duration of the service**.

LIGHTING THE ADVENT WREATH

John the Baptist proclaimed, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near." And the people went out to him and were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. And John said, "I baptize you with water for repentance, but one who is more powerful than I is coming after me; I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire." We light the first Advent candle to remind us to keep awake and be ready. We light the second Advent candle to remind us to change our ways.
