Music Notes

The composer of There's a Light A-Comin', David Lanz III (1950-), is best known for his works in the new age instrumental and adult alternative genres – he has characterized his music as "heavy mellow." (If you would like a taste of what "heavy mellow" might mean you can go to Youtube and search for David Lanz Norwegian Rain.) While he has other sacred works to his credit, they are not his primary focus. Early in his career he thought about the power of music to get people to dance, to meditate, to go march into battle. His interests led him to East Asian music and its ability to create trances. He states that his music has been used by both traditional and alternative healers and, while he does not attribute healing powers to his music, he does believe that music, "...can set the stage and create the inner atmosphere ..." to allow individuals to tap into their own healing abilities. In our anthem today, Lanz showcases his talent for creating music that creates both mood and energy. The instruction for our piece is "with excitement," establishing the mood. A driving bass line brings extra energy and we hope that Lanz's music will contribute to your "inner atmosphere" for this Advent season.
