MUSIC NOTE

During February, in recognition of Black History Month, we celebrate the tradition of African-American spirituals. This Sunday we offer three pieces in this tradition.

In "I Will Arise," the first verse is the refrain from a 1759 hymn by the English composer Joseph Hart entitled, "Come, Ye Sinners, Poor and Needy." In the late 19th century it was included in a compilation entitled Gospel Hymns becoming part of the American spiritual tradition. Our version is the creation of Alice Parker and Robert Shaw.

The text for "Go and Tell John" is taken from Matthew 11:4-6. In verses 1-3, John the Baptist is in prison and has heard of Jesus's works. He sends his disciples to find out if this Jesus is the "Coming One." In verses 4-6, Jesus does not declare that he is the Messiah, but rather he tells John's disciples to report what they have seen and heard – the effects of belief in him.

"My Lord, what a mornin" cites Revelation 8 as text but it draws on a variety of apocalyptic verses. First noted in Slave Songs of the United States (1867), this arrangement by Burleigh uses a portion of the full original text.
