About the Music

What's in the Choir Library?

If you have ever gone into the Music Room you might see a good deal of music. Perhaps half the wall space is shelving that contains numbered boxes – each with copies of a single piece of music. These are works that have been purchased over decades; some old enough to be completely falling apart. There are over 1,500 boxed pieces and we continue to add new ones. But that is not the extent of the library!

There are anthem books that might contain 40 or more individual pieces. There are also complete oratories, and if you count the individual choruses they might have 20 individual pieces. For example, there are 17 choruses in Handel's Messiah. In total, there are probably close to 2,000 pieces that the Church's Music Director can choose from at any time. In an average year, the choir probably sings 70-80 pieces. Buried in that 2,000 total are perhaps 100 different pieces/extended works for children's or youth choirs.

All the works are categorized in two ways. A computer file has details on each numbered piece in order. There is also a card file for each piece alphabetized by title.

You will also see some bookshelves crammed with music. One contains our hymnal library with books from many of the Protestant traditions in multiple editions, as well as specialized hymnals. The other case contains individual copies of many works that can be used as references.

The Church on the Hill has invested in its music programs since its founding and the Library is a living testament to all the musicians who have helped lead its worship.
