About the Music

Over the next three Sundays, the choir will be offering anthems by the American composer Hal Hopson (1933-). Hopson is one of the best-known living American composers of church music. A quick review of online sources shows the number of his works ranging from about 1,000 with one entry stating that there are over 3,000 works; 1,300 is the most commonly cited number. Certainly one of the reasons for this range is the different types of works Hopson has created. To his credit, he has many original works of many different types. But perhaps the area he has been most active is in arranging compositions of others. He has composed many responses -- very short pieces. He has also composed oratories which include multiple stand-alone pieces. So the wide difference in number of credited works is understandable. But regardless of the number, Hopson is one of the best-loved composers of the COTH choir.
