About the Music

If you've ever watched the British television program *The Vicar of Dibley* you know Howard Goodall's version of the 23rd Psalm, "The Lord is My Shepard." Goodall wrote the work as a commission for the series. Interestingly he chose different editions of the King James Bible for different verses and the piece does not incorporate the entire text of the Psalm; leaving out verses three and five.

"Let Us with a Gladsome Mind" is a hymn by the British author/poet John Milton (1608-1674). Known as one of the greatest of all British writers, Milton wrote 32 hymns of which "Let Us..." is by far the best known. As with many hymns, over time some verses fall into disuse. Alan Ridout's arrangement leaves out three of the original verses. One missing verse is as follows: "Let us therefore warble forth His high majesty and worth: for His mercies shall endure, ever faithful ever sure." Can you think of another hymn with the word "warble"? Milton did use warble in a number of compositions but we can't think of any other such hymn usage.
