#### Introduction

Dr. Prophet F.W. Hood has been chosen by God to walk in the office of Prophet. He is an ordained Baptist minister that serves as the founder of F.W. Hood Ministries. Prophet Hood has a specialized Educational, Homiletics, and Spiritual Formation Ministry that is orchestrated by the Holy Ghost to create a Prophetic Ministry that fully nurtures, cultivates, and nourishes the individual in a holistic manner. Transforming the individual while empowering communities as well.

Dr. Hood received his Bachelor's Degree in Humanities at The College of New Rochelle, a Master of Divinity from New Brunswick Theological Seminary, a Master of Religion and Religious Education in Spiritual Direction from Fordham University, and a Doctor of Ministry degree in Transformational Preaching from New Brunswick Theological Seminary.

Dr. Hood's secular ministry has been in the field of social services, working for programs that service those who are homeless, who suffer abuses of all kinds. Those living with HIV/AIDS, rape victims, drug/alcohol abuse, and those involved in drug treatment (family court). He has served in many capacities

from counselor to outreach coordinator to job developer to developing and conducting seminars. Prophet Hood states, "I have learned and experienced a lot through serving the needs of others and have become the better for it."

He continues to say, "The life of any servant of God is not an easy life and as I say often to those that I Minster to, a walk with God is intense but a walk in God is sublime." My Prophetic walk in God has not made me popular or made me welcome, however, what it continues to do is fashion my life in a way that honors God, and a life of devotion which pleases God.
