About the Music

"Lord, Make Me an Instrument of Thy Peace" is subtitled "Prayer of St. Francis." Indeed, this text is widely regarded as having been written by St. Francis (c.1182-1226). However, these verses show up nowhere in his writings. In fact, there is no record anywhere of this prayer until 1912. In addition to our version by David Stanley York, other settings of the prayer have been composed by, among others, Bing Crosby, Donovan, Patti Smith, John Rutter, and Sarah McLachlan.

Ola Gjeilo's (1978-) "The Ground" is part of a larger work; Sunrise Mass. Interestingly, although Gjeilo chose Latin for the text of the Mass, the section titles are in English. Gjeilo combines the Sanctus and the Agnus Dei components of the standard Mass into a single movement with the English title "Identity & The Ground." Gjeilo later expanded "The Ground" section to the stand-alone work we offer this morning. Of "The Ground," Gjeilo wrote, "The chorale,...is the culmination of the Mass, and...I wanted to convey a sense of having 'arrived' at the end...; to have reached a kind of peace and grounded strength, after the long journey of the Mass..." The work ends with a quiet setting of the plea for peace; Dona Nobis Pacem.
