The Lord be with you.


And also with you.

Most righteous God, we remember in this Supper the perfect sacrifice offered once on the cross by our Lord Jesus Christ for the sin of the whole world. In the joy of his resurrection and in expectation of his coming again, we offer ourselves to you as holy and living sacrifices. Together we proclaim the mystery of the faith:

## Christ has died! Christ is risen! Christ will come again!

Send your Holy Spirit upon us, we pray, that the bread which we break and the cup which we bless may be to us the communion of the body and blood of Christ. Grant that, being joined together in him, we may attain to the unity of the faith and grow up in all things into Christ our Lord. And as this grain has been gathered from many fields into one loaf, and these grapes from many hills into one cup, grant, O Lord, that your whole Church may soon be gathered from the ends of the earth into your kingdom. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!



#### The Communion—Words of Institution

(We partake of the Cup.)

The cup of blessing which we bless is the communion of the blood of Christ.

## **Thanksgiving after Communion**

Brothers and sisters, since the Lord has now fed us at his Table, let us praise God's holy name with heartfelt thanksgiving! Bless the Lord, O my soul, **and all that is within me**, **bless his holy name**.

Bless the Lord, O my soul, and do not forget all his benefits—

Who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases,

Who redeems your life from the Pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy.

The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities.

For as the heavens are high above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him;

As far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.

As a father has compassion for his children, so the Lord has compassion for those who fear him,

Who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all, and will also give us all things with him. Therefore shall my mouth and heart show forth the praise of the Lord, from this time forth forevermore. Amen. (From Psalm 103, with additions)

## About the Music

"I am Alpha and Omega" by John Stainer (1840-1901) is an anthem for Trinity Sunday – in our Reformed tradition, the first Sunday after Pentecost. The text is a combination of Revelation 1:8 ("I am the Alpha and the Omega...") and the Sanctus (Holy, Holy, Holy...).

"Oh Taste and See" is based on Psalm 34:8. This is a Psalm of David and perhaps the phrase "taste and see" is the most significant in the verse. Commentators have pointed out that this phrase calls for the reader to test the goodness of God for themselves – you cannot know God through the experience of others but only by "tasting" for yourself. An added point is that "tasting" is not a passive act – the taste is not simply given to you. You must be active and choose to engage with God. R. Vaughn Williams (1872-1958) composed this piece for the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II in 1953.
