About the Music

The hymn "Flee as a Bird" – today offered as an anthem– shows text by M.B.S. Dana – a designation that understates the complexity of the author's name. Mary Stanley Bunce Palmer (1810-1883) added Dana upon marriage to become Mary Stanley Bunce Palmer Dana. You can see that our music has the initial sequence wrong. After the death of her husband, she later remarried and became Mary Shindler. You can find her music listed under Mary Dana, Mary Dana Shindler, Mary Shindler, and Mary S.B. Dana. Apparently, she was best known as Mrs. Dana.

The anthem text draws on a multitude of Biblical texts. The source listed is Psalm 11:1. However, only the phrase "flee as a bird" comes from that Psalm. In ancient, non-Biblical, texts the phrase meant a hasty, disorganized retreat from battle but to the Psalmist the phrase is used to indicate a return to God's love and law. For Dana, we are lone and helpless birds fleeing and seeking refuge from our sins. In today's arrangement (by L. B. Sateren, 1913-2007) the initial indication is Legato – most generally treated as slow with notes connected and sung smoothly. When we get to the text, "Fly, for the avenger is near you" the direction is "Brighter." The original version of the work shows a change at this point to a major key and the direction is "Agitato." In either case, the music moves from a mood of contemplation to urgency with the arrival of the avenger. We need a place of refuge. We need God.

Introduction

Victor Han- Upon finding God at a Tri-Annual Festival at Indiana University while in High School in 1985, started attending Staten Island Presbyterian Church shortly thereafter. In 1986, became a youth leader at SI Presbyterian Church, which kick-started my journey as a Sunday School Teacher. In 1987, became a permanent member of the Korean American Presbyterian Church in Queens (KAPCQ). In 1988, became a Sunday School Teacher for Junior and Senior High students. Taught at KAPCQ till 2005. In 1994, was certified in Reverend D. James Kennedy's Evangelism Explosion. In 2000, was ordained as a Deacon at KAPCQ and was the President of the Young Men's Group (ages 25 to 35). Attended KAPCQ until June of 2006. In 2009, started attending The Salvation Army, Flushing Corps. Shortly upon attending, became a Sunday School Teacher for High School and College Students. In 2014, promoted to Young Person Sergeant Major (Youth Elder) and led the English Ministry until June of 2016. From August of 2016 to November of 2018, attended Choongsyn Korean Church in NY (Reformed Church in America) and was a High School Sunday School teacher till November 2018. In December of 2018, started attending Church on the Hill, where I was ordained as an Elder in June of 2020.
