Music Notes

"I Love Thee" comes to us from Jeremiah Ingall's (1764-1808) Christian Harmony published in 1805 (not to be confused with The Christian Harmony compiled by William Walker in 1866). The composer of the piece itself is unknown. In addition to the anthem version we offer today, the work is in many hymnals with an additional verse. The arranger of our version is Benjamin Harlan (1954-present). In addition to a lifetime of service to multiple churches as minister of music, he has been devoted to fostering congregational hymn singing. In an interview in 2019 as he prepared to retire he explained, "...when it comes down to the basics, the Word, prayer, and singing together are the most important components of Christian worship."

Devoted readers of Music Notes will recall that "God is Our Refuge" was offered on Psalm Sunday so we will not repeat that summary other than to note that the text is from Psalm 46:1-3, 8. But it is worth adding that verse 9 is one of the most significant in this Psalm: "He [God] makes wars cease to the ends of the earth; He breaks the bow and shatters the spear; he burns the shields with fire." (NRSV) Psalm 46 is a vision of God's world at peace.
